### ***Take BAC Congress Builds National Coalition of 100+ Congressional Candidates***

**Providence, R.I. — April 22, 2026** — Take BAC Congress, a political initiative focused on government accountability and structural reform, is highlighting its growing network of congressional candidates aligned around a shared platform.

The organization brings together candidates who support proposed changes aimed at increasing transparency and reducing conflicts of interest in the federal government. The coalition's publicly listed signatories include over 100 congressional candidates from 38 states, representing both U.S. House and Senate races and reflecting a broad national effort.

The initiative was founded by Andrew Sneed, a candidate for Alabama's 5th Congressional District. The coalition includes individuals from a range of professional backgrounds, including military service, business, and community leadership.

Take BAC Congress outlines several policy priorities, including support for congressional term limits, restrictions on stock trading by members of Congress, and limits on post-service lobbying. The organization also advocates for reducing the influence of outside funding in federal elections and strengthening ethics requirements for elected officials.

Representatives of the initiative describe the effort as a response to declining public confidence in government institutions, positioning the coalition as focused on governance reform rather than a single-issue campaign.
